

The Vines Willamette Pinot Noir 2020

Region: Dundee Hills, Willamette Valley, Oregon **Winemaking partner:** Bryan Weil of Alexana

Varietal Composition: 100% Pinot Noir, from Alexana's geologically diverse estate: 25% Pommard Block 7, 20% Dijon 777,

20% Dijon 115, 20% Coury, 15% Dijon 113

Soil Composition: This is one of the most geologically diverse vineyard sites in North America if not the world, with 55 planted acres on 18 different soil types. The vineyard is dry-farmed and sits between 320 feet and 650 feet elevation.

Winemaking: Vinified in stainless steel

Aging: 10 months in oak, 32% of which was new

Alcohol: 13.1%

Tasting Notes: Notes of raspberry and cherry are followed by hints of crisp red apple, fig and citrus fruits. Juicy but with

excellent acidity for balance.

Production: 300 bottles
